



### **AEA Knowledge Leaders present at The Carbon Show**

AEA Knowledge Leaders, Daniel Waller and Heather Haydock, will be sharing their understanding of some of the key issues in carbon management at The Carbon Show, on the 29 and 30 September 2009.

The Carbon Show ([www.thecarbonshow.com](http://www.thecarbonshow.com)), to be held at ExCel in London Docklands, is the first international exhibition dedicated to carbon, covering a range of topics, from carbon consulting, carbon audits, to low carbon solutions for business.

Heather Haydock, AEA's Knowledge Leader in Climate Change Policy, will be presenting on day two. Heather will be discussing Marginal Abatement Cost Curves and their use for those organisations who want to set and achieve carbon reduction targets in the most cost effective way.

The Carbon Show promises to be an essential forum to source the latest advice and resources that will help your organisation to take advantage of the opportunities presented by the Government's progressive carbon reduction targets.
